

Eucalyptus Flower Care Guide

Whether you prefer a beautiful vase arrangement or a refreshing shower experience, we have put together some simple care instructions for you to follow:

- 1. Unboxing your Eucalyptus:** Once you receive your package, carefully remove the eucalyptus stems from the box. Gently unwrap them to avoid any damage.
- 2. Trim the Stems:** Using sharp scissors or pruners, cut about an inch off the bottom of each stem at a diagonal angle. This will create a fresh cut, allowing the stems to absorb water more effectively.
